For 400 points:

- THE TWINS: Where did the twins' mother work in New York City: Coney Island Amusement Park
- PUERTO RICO: What caused the need for Puerto Ricans to migrate back and forth to the United States: US factories moved out of Puerto Rico
- BENEFITS OF NEW YORK: In New York the twins would be on the fast track for great _____: careers
- BENEFITS OF HOME VILLAGE: What special food dish could the twins get in their home village: *arroz con gandules*
